

TOWN OF AMHERST 2016 DOG NOTICE/APPLICATION

All dogs in the State of Wisconsin over 5 months must be vaccinated for rabies and licensed under State Statute #174-05. Failure to do so may cost you over \$169.00.

The Town Treasurer will be at the Town of Amherst Municipal Building, 4023 County Road Q, Amherst Junction on **SATURDAYS: January 16, February 13 and March 12, 2016** from 9:00 a.m. to noon to accept payment for dog licenses. Please bring in a current copy of their rabies vaccination certificate. Fees are \$8.00 if they are spayed or neutered (proof needed), \$20.00, if intact - please note the increase. A late filing fee of \$5.00 per dog is required if paid after **March 31, 2016**. The Treasurer is able to do this from her home as well. Please call ahead: 715-824-3951 or 715-572-5686.

You may also license your dog by mail, but **must** include the following: Copy of current rabies vaccination certificate, proof of being neutered or spayed, the name, breed and color of dog along with the correct fees and a self addressed, stamped envelope for license and certificate return, to Amherst Town Treasurer, 10928 Floistad Road, Amherst, WI 54406. ,

TOWN OF AMHERST RECYCLING AND GARBAGE

The Town of Amherst contracts their garbage and recycling pickup through Harter's Fox Valley Disposal. Their phone number is 888-804-8556.

Garbage and recycling will be picked up **every** Wednesday, except for the following Holiday weeks: Memorial Day and Labor Day, when it will be done on Thursday. Christmas and New Year's should be unaffected. Harter's will pick up large items, for a fee, every other Thursday, starting on Jan. 6. Call by 2 pm the Wednesday before, to get put on their pick up list and for pricing.
